14/15-41 Apologies

Cllrs Midgley and Coy were unable to attend.

It was noted that Cllr Coy had not attended meetings during the last 5 months and the Chairman would remind him of the 6 month rule (Section 85-Local Government Act 1972)

14/15-42 Approval of Minutes

14/15-43 Declarations of Interest

14/15-44 Action Points from last meeting

- (a) **Bus Service** - Cllr Langley reported that the Festival Committee had resolved to fund a weekly bus service to and from Sleaford on a trial basis for 6 months to commence shortly.

NKDC Sleaford Transport Strategy referred to in a recent press article promises various accessibility issues which do not address concerns in South Kyme and it was :

RESOLVED: That the Council lobby the Secretary of State for Transport and that contact be made with the press to follow up the matters outlined in the recent 'Sleaford Target' article.

- (b) **Pumping Station** – An application had been lodged with the Woodland Trust for 30 plants which the Trust will consider in January 2015 and if successful the plants will be supplied in March 2015.

- (c) **Defibrillator/First Aid training** – The Golf Club had ordered the required cabinet for the defibrillator and would arrange installation. The cost is £530 which the Council will re-imburse on receipt of a VAT invoice.

St John Ambulance had quoted £500 to provide a 3 hour first aid course for up to 12 people. It was felt that the cost outweighs the benefit and that further quotes be sought.

14/15-45 Dog Fouling Surveillance

Despite Council's recent campaigns the problem of dog fouling continues and it was proposed that consideration be given to installation of CCTV cameras in vulnerable areas.

14/15-46 Street furniture maintenance

It was noted that wooden benches and planters along with the Kingfisher sculpture were in need of some maintenance as was the Slea memorial.

RESOLVED: That the necessary work be undertaken. **Action Chairman**

14/15-47 Village Christmas Tree

The public spirited donation of a tree was noted with thanks and a working party would be arranged to collect and erect it.

14/15-48 Slea Working Party

- (a) River levels were maintained at 2.35-2.45m and funding was in place for automated gates to prevent variations in levels.
- (b) A privately funded turning circle to be completed before May Day was supported by Slea Navigation.
- (c) An access point near the Kingfisher sculpture awaited Vole activity in Spring. Planning would be required which would be handled by either Slea Navigation or Council depending on cost.

RESOLVED: That enquiries be made to ascertain if Parish Councils had preferential rates for planning applications. **Action Clerk**
